### Against Freemasonry

Freemasons were the protagonists, foot-soldiers of the enemies of Christ since the Crucifixion, with the same agenda (not having one of their own) hell-bent on infiltrating the Church and implementing Modernism. Issues are identified, along with warnings and condemnations (including excommunication) throughout the encyclicals of the period. This is a selection of particulars.
