- This is the full set of columns that are required to uniquely identify a person, it is virtually the international standard.
- However, it is too wide for a Primary Key, to be migrated into child tables
- Thus
 - a surrogate PersonID is added (a surrogate is always an addition, it is not a replacement)
 - the Primary Key is demoted to an Alternate Key
 - the surrogate takes the position of Primary Key
- allowing a narrow key to be migrated to the child tables
