### **Exclusion Notice under Event Conduct and Exclusion Policy**

We refer to the Mensa Event Conduct and Exclusion Policy, copy attached, and advise you are hereby excluded from the monthly drinks and dinner event at the Old Commodore Hotel in North Sydney until further notice or 12 months.

The decision follows repeated warnings to you about your aggression, including covert, to other members including the State Secretary. Your fixations and overt expressions on bizarre ideas concerning race, religion and gender are offensive and have been the source of continual complaints.

In the context of the current volatile political and social climate where antisemitic sentiments such as yours are now being expressed with deadly violence, our event in public at the Commodore cannot involve further risk to the welfare of members and the reputation of Mensa.

We have carefully considered what we should do, and am satisfied that exclusion of you by the appropriate notice is the least punitive and restrictive measure we can take.

As per the policy, if you do attend the premises and approach a group or table of members, they will be advised of the existence of the notice, shown copies if we have them, and be asked to either not engage with you or declare themselves as

separated from the Mensa event. If they do, they can then interact with you at another table separately to the group partaking in our event.

We trust there will be no occasion for such unpleasantness, and wish you well with enjoyment of the other things Mensa has to offer.
